


### **Integration and the Marine Corps**

Back on on 4 January the assistant commandant, Maj. Gen. Oliver P. Smith, had said , black units would be formed "in any area where there is an expressed interest" provided that this is the botte the black population was large enough to support it."



Roy Wilkins of the NAACP wrote SecDef Johnson today, objecting to the creation of another all-black Marine reserve unit in New York City.
